

Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds. **PROVERBS 27:23**

Tell me about your relationship with Jesus. When did Jesus become more than a name to you? (Know God)

Listen to their story. If they do not yet have a relationship with Jesus, don't feel like you need to have the answers, but rather be ready to let them know you'll be praying for them around what they shared.

Offer to pray with them, either right then or when the time is right, making Jesus Lord and Savior of their life.

Consider sharing your personal story/testimony.

Invite them to attend a weekend service.

Are you regularly attending a weekend service? (Know God)

If no, offer to meet them for a weekend service and sit with them.

Describe your daily Bible reading. Do you use a Bible reading plan? (Know God)

If no, direct them to The Daily, located on the CedarCreek app.

Have you been water baptized since you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior? (Know God)

If no, encourage them to be baptized during the first weekend of the month.

Give them the Baptism Study Guide.

Invite the rest of the Group to come for support. This can be so encouraging for the entire Group!

Who is your "one" - the person you want to invite to a weekend service or invest in to help move one step?

If they don't have one, help them see the areas where they have influence and help them identify one person they could begin investing in. (Friends, Family, Work, Neighborhood, etc.)

If they have one, help them identify one specific way they could invest in that relationship this semester.

Commit to praying for each other's "one."

Do you have relationships that offer accountability? (Find Freedom)

If no, encourage them to continue in Group life and to specifically find an accountability partner. Have you completed GrowthTrack? (Discover Purpose)

If no, encourage them to attend GrowthTrack (available at every campus). Remind them that it does not have to be done in order, so they can jump in at any time! Offer to meet your Group members there to attend GrowthTrack together.

Have you identified your spiritual gifts? Are you using them to serve on the DreamTeam? (Discover Purpose/Make a Difference)

If no, encourage them to attend GrowthTrack where they can take steps to begin discovering purpose. Week 2

Are you giving regularly? (Know God/Make a Difference)

If no, share your story about how and why you give regularly.

Share what the Bible teaches about generosity and giving with heart, as well as what we teach as a church about giving a percentage, as a priority, and progressively.

Tell me about your prayer life. Do you have a time, place, and plan to pray? (Know God)

If no, direct them to the personal prayer guide located in Group Leader Resources section on the CedarCreek app.

What does God have you dreaming

about lately? (Discover Purpose/Make a Difference)

Listening to what people are dreaming and thinking about can be a window into what they are passionate about as well as key ways God may be calling them to make a difference.

Celebrate the dream and ask what their next step is.
